Selection Process

- Young professionals from the greater Huntsville area may submit an application by June 12, 2026.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Development Council Nominating Committee.
- All candidates will be contacted on decision by July 13, 2026.
- This year, there are only 10 available spots to fill for the council

Term of Commitment

- 3 years
- September–May; some opportunities during summer break

Time Requirements

- Required time commitment of approximately 30 hours per year.
- New members must attend New Member Orientation
- New members must attend Development Council Kick-off event
- Members meet on a monthly basis for meetings or tours, mostly during lunch time (noon–1 p.m.).
- Service projects, signature events, volunteer opportunities and other activities might be after work hours or during weekends.
- Members must attend 80% of all Development Council activities.

Fundraising

All Development Council members are asked to make an annual donation to any Huntsville Hospital Foundation fund of their choice. Amount and designation is at the discretion of the member. Our goal is to have 100% participation from Development Council each year.
